A. Caspar Community Center

Executive Director's Report

We are short on kitchen help and clean up for this weekend's breakfast. David suggested we hire someone to do final dish and pot washing.

Kitchen

We are keeping within budget, though we are \$10,000 over our amended \$20,000 for appliances due to upgrades; we owe Paul R. \$1,000 for work to date plus whatever he will need to cover the remainder of his stewardship. Chris and Dan do not foresee any more change orders.

Paul S. reminded the Board that the kitchen was the original project core and we should not scrimp.

Paul R. has made sure there are appropriate outdoor electrical outlets.

There was a short discussion about the refrigerator/freezer configuration; it was decided to stay with the refrigerator-freezer combo.

The current sterilizer was purchased with a Community Foundation Grant. We will return it to the CF for use by someone else.

The Marmoleum has been ordered. We would pay a 10% restocking fee if we cancel. In light of Oscar's objections to Marmoleum, Paul S. offered to do more research on cost/durability/greenness and outgassing smell.

Dalen has already received calls regarding the commercial use of the kitchen and will consult with Chubby's.

Other Related

We will need a week without the construction crew in the south room so we can refinish the floor; we also need volunteers.

We need to pay for the final inspection on the Mail Pavilion. Dalen will call the Building Department.
