E. Facilities

The solar project is moving forward, but putting the panels on the roof is more complicated than previously thought. Dave Duncan will come do an engineering report before sending in plans to the building department.

Judy reported that we can get an exemption from a Coastal Development permit for a cover for the cob oven. Paul S. offered to talk with Paul

Garvin and John Wozniak about coming up with a design. Judy will take plans to building department.

F. Fundraising/Events

A volunteer appreciation party is in the works. Dalen will send out potential dates.

G. Community Planning and Outreach

The recently attended neighborhood meetings averaged 18-20 attendees. Community Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, July 13 at 4:00 p.m. David Alden had an idea of forming a 501c3 to provide safe drinking water to the community. This organization could seek funds to purchase the water parcels and supply water to the members.

The hiring committee and Dalen are narrowing down the applicants and will decide on the position in the next month.
